

## **STS International Education Priorities - 2025**

#### **Latin and South America**

- 1. Continue co-branded collaboration with EACTS and LACES on a live, cardiac standalone meeting in December in Latin America.
  - a. 2025: STS-run meeting in Lima, Peru
  - b. 2026: EACTS-run meeting, location TBD but with an eye toward the northern part of the region (Panama, Costa Rica, Mexico City, Colombia)
  - c. Continue to ensure there is congenital content on the program.
  - d. Work with EACTS and LACES to transfer more logistical and financial responsibility of the meeting to LACES, so that there is clarity regarding expectation of financial autonomy by 2030.
- 2. Further support for collaborative thoracic education.
  - a. Collaborate with ESTS, EACTS, and the Sociedad Española de Cirugía Torácica (SECT), and leading Latin and South American thoracic societies on a joint 1-day post-conference symposium at the May 2025 meeting of the Sociedade Brasileira de Cirurgia Torácica (SBCT). The SBCT meeting is biannual, taking place in odd-numbered years.
  - b. Facilitate discussions with society partners in the region on formation of a pan-Latin/South American organization to elevate continental collaboration (similar to LACES).
  - c. Strategy for 2026 should be determined shortly after the 2025 SBCT meeting, in particular evaluating the efficacy of a potential standalone meeting in May, 2026 structured similar to the 2023 meeting.
- 3. Other areas of opportunity:
  - a. Continue support for the Latin Heart Rounds brand of webinars and livestreamed meeting sessions. Continue a broad focus on topics that include adult cardiac, thoracic and congenital topics.
  - Seek proposal ideas for joint/reciprocal annual meeting sessions with stakeholder societies, especially on thoracic or congenital topics. Note the STS 2026 Annual Meeting is in New Orleans, and 2027 meeting is in San Diego.



### Asia-Pacific

- 1. Expand STS impact at the ASCVTS Annual Meeting (Singapore, spring 2025) by collaborating with EACTS on a multi-session workshop.
- 2. Evaluate outcome of the 2024 STS-ASCVTS Aortic Summit and recommend next steps.
- 3. Partner with KTCVS on a third iteration of the Heart Valve Disease Forum in 2025 Korea.
- 4. Other areas of opportunity:
  - Seek proposal ideas for development of 1-2 activities in support of thoracic or congenital education.
  - b. Seek proposal ideas for increased engagement with Chinese societies.

# **Europe**

- Continue reciprocal joint sessions with EACTS and ESTS at respective annual meetings.
- 2. Expand the presence of EACTS at the STS Coronary Conference with formal recognition and expansion of marketing and program planning support.
- 3. Work to expand awareness of the Cardiothoracic Surgery E-Book and increase institutional sales.

### **South Asia**

- 1. Empower the newly created South Asia Education Task Force to develop 2 webinars in collaboration with the Indian Association of Cardiovascular-Thoracic Surgeons (IACTS) and other societies in the region.
- 2. Establish a regular meeting cadence for the Task Force and explore how best to build relationships with key stakeholders/societies in the region.
- 3. Seek proposal ideas for development of 1-2 future activities.

## Middle East/Africa

- 1. Engage with European and Asian society partners in discussions about possible future projects.
- 2. Seek proposal ideas for development of 1-2 virtual activities.
