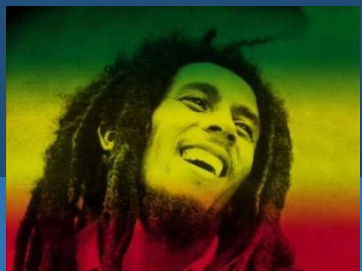

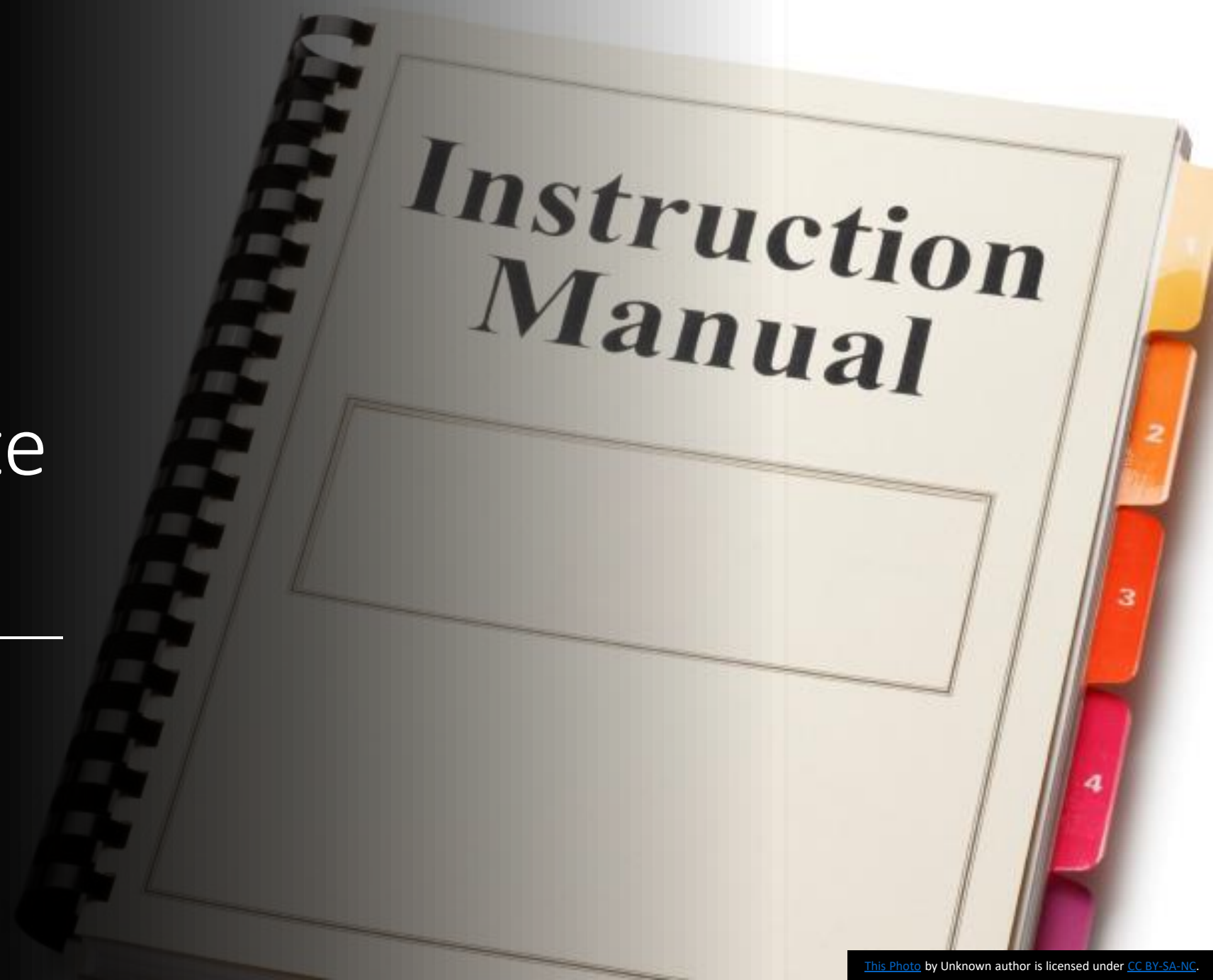

# Font color in the new training manual

- Green font is from a previous month. Red font is the most recent month updated. Blue font is often a hyperlink to an additional resource.

**Procedure Inclusion** – All procedures must include a surgeon that is listed in the participation agreement with the STS. Please refer to the [Procedure Inclusion Guide](#) on the website. This is not an all-inclusive list of procedures to be included and optional cases are to be added at the discretion of the Participating Surgeon. If you have a procedure that you are uncertain as to whether it should go into the manual, please send in a question to the FAQ Mailbox. **Update Dec 2020 – Cancelled or Aborted cases without any procedure performed are not entered into V 4.2.**

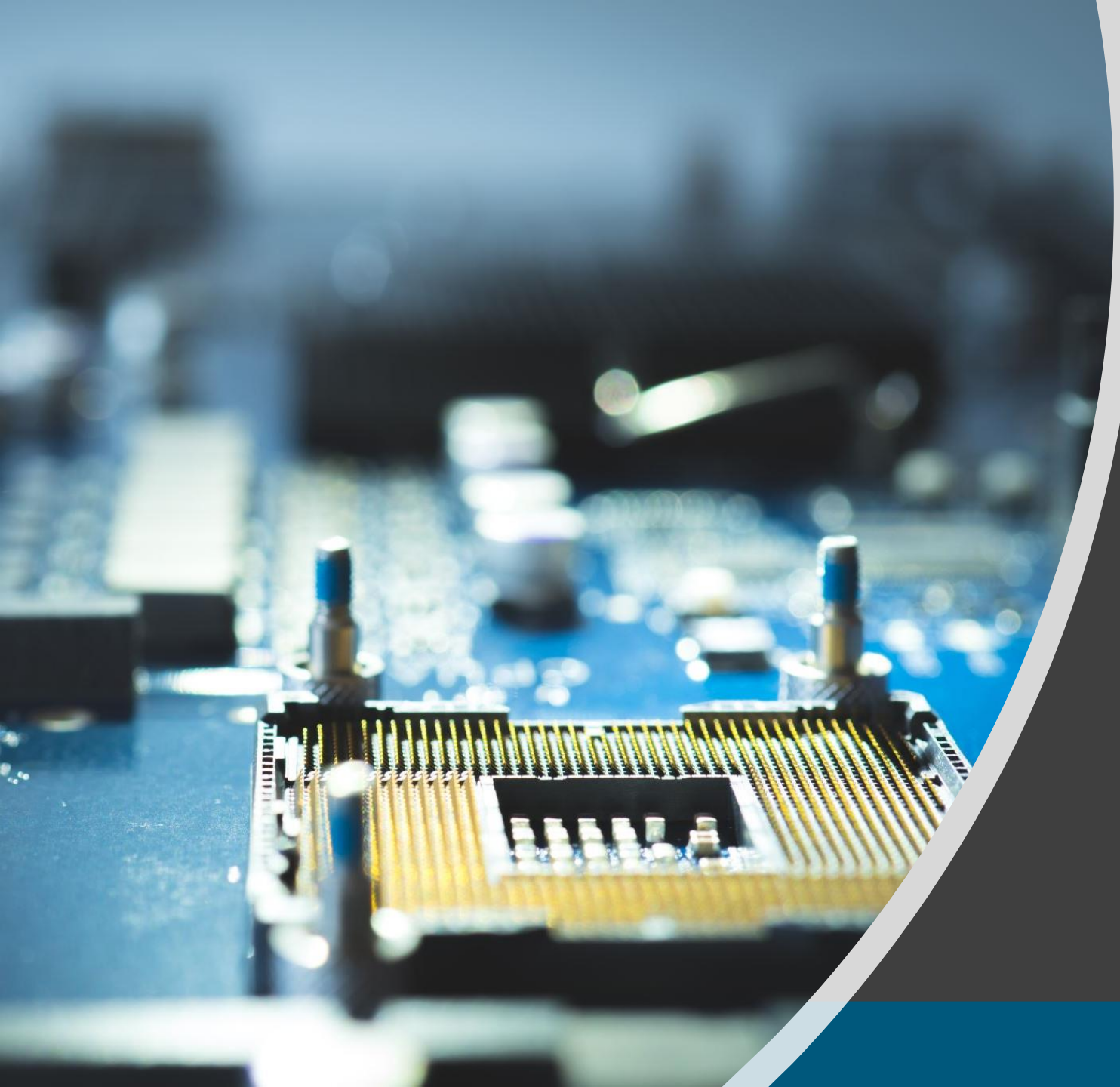
Spirometry results that have not been interpreted by a pulmonologist may be used to quantify chronic lung disease.

**Time Frame:** Do not use values obtained more than 12 months prior to the date of surgery. **Update July 2021 – Code the study closest and prior to OR Entry.**

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- Questions will no longer be distributed – only clarification provided.
- Not all questions submitted will be included with FAQ's – for example answers to specific clinical scenarios are not likely to be included.
- If you have a question about a procedure performed or whether a case must be submitted, please include the operative note and pathology report (if applicable)

### **\*\*Report Enhancement**

#### **Risk Adjusted Dashboard Report – Opt-Out Feature Enabled**

- **STS-6841** – Users who opt out of receiving a risk adjusted report will no longer have an option to view the reporting date range for the results for the opted-out harvest. Functionality has been added to the report parameter page where the reporting period will be hidden from sites who submit an opt-out request to STS.

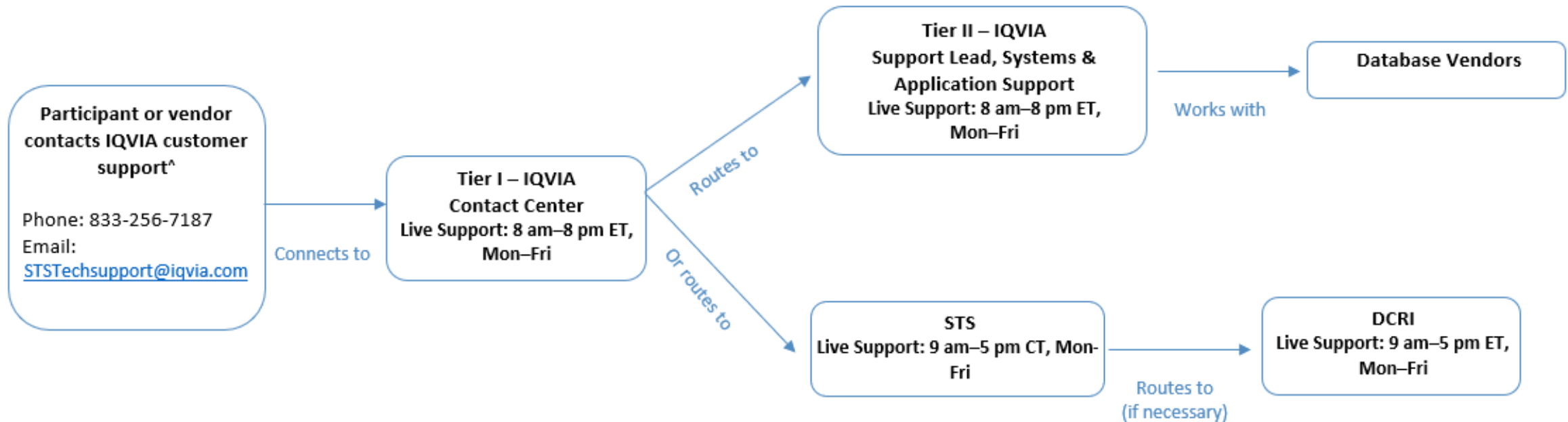
