Dear Chairman Tiberi and Ranking Member Pascrell:

The undersigned organizations are pleased to offer our support for HR 3163, the *Medicare Part B Home Infusion Services Temporary Transitional Payment Act.* We thank you for introducing this bipartisan legislation to ensure that Medicare beneficiaries continue to have access to lifesaving infusion therapies.

HR 3163 creates a temporary transitional payment beginning January 1, 2019, for critical services associated with Part B infusion drugs. This transitional payment ensures that our most fragile patients do not experience a "care gap" while the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) works to finalize a permanent services payment from the *21st Century Cures Act*, scheduled for January 2021. This temporary and transitional payment will allow cardiac patients to continue to undergo home inotropic infusions as part of palliative, end-of-life care or as a bridge to cardiac transplantation. We urge all members to support enactment of HR 3163 as soon as possible.

Thank you and your staff for your efforts to introduce this vital legislation. We commend you for your leadership and look forward to working with you as this moves forward.
