




Good news! The new education platform uses your current STS credentials.

My Dashboard contains overall announcements about the new platform.


The *In Progress* widget lists the most recent curriculum topics accessed.

You will mainly work in the *My Program* tab.







The **Overview** tab presents a list of content, the basic and advanced objectives, and links to download the PowerPoint files for case presentations.


